But I learnt the importance of equity, and how to listen. It changed my perspective. I learnt the value of women, and the importance of their contributions if I give them that opportunity.

The conference featured a dynamic panel discussion on gender equity and reconciliation in the workplace, with GERI Facilitators Ariana Blossom, Jorge Rico, Myra Kinds, Will Keepin, Cynthia Brix, and SheTek Founder Chaya Pamula. This was followed by an experiential workshop entitled "*Gender Harmony in the Workplace*," giving participants a chance to address specific gender challenges encountered in the workplace.

Future was the title of since 2015, GERI had this hybrid conference, July 26-30, convened by FemmeQ. This was an inspiring five days, with over 400 people attending. GERI Co-Founders Cynthia Brix and Will Keepin presented independently at the conference, on their respective topics: The Power of *Gender Equity and* Reconciliation and Presencing the Divine Feminine.

In reflecting on the conference, Karen Downes, Founder of FemmeQ said, "It was and will continue to be a moment in time when a shift occurred in the paradigm. Our message went far and wide. Hearts have been touched by the sharing of your stories, minds opened through new ideas presented, and people catalyzed into action."

a presence at the Parliament of World Religions, the largest interfaith gathering in the world. A panel session entitled The New Compassionate Male was held at the 2021 Parliament in October, convened by **GERI Facilitator Clay** Boykin and moderated by Dennis Tardan. The conference panel featured GERI Trainer Karambu Ringera and co-Founders Will Keepin and Cynthia Brix, archetypal cosmologist Richard Tarnas, and Sarah Jamil and Donna Mills from the Charter for Compassion. In a separate conference session, Will Keepin gave a presentation on the universal divine feminine across the major world religions, and the spiritual and mystical implications.

### A Big Year in Latin America

In September last year we launched the first online course in Spanish for Latin America.
Since then, there have been four additional GERI courses in Spanish, plus monthly follow-up meetings. Participants have joined from Mexico, Guatemala, Costa Rica, Colombia, Bolivia, Peru, Puerto Rico, Venezuela, Brazil, Chile, and Argentina. A new GERI course in Spanish / Portuguese will begin on November 27, and another course for Spain is in the works.


