We shared stories from the depths of our hearts, listened together, laughed together, cried together, celebrated together, and through it all, came to know one another as friends and began to reawaken the rightful harmony, balance, and mutual reverence in which we are called to live.



"I was renewed, shaped, challenged, connected, healed and inspired... The sharing from women to men touched my heart deeply... I made my decision not to keep quiet anymore and will always advocate for women created in the image of God as our mothers, wives, daughters, sisters and nieces," said Philbert Kalisa, the Founder and CEO of REACH in Rwanda.
