Earlier this month, 57 youth, aged 15-17, from Pune, India completed the three-day introductory training with Gender Equity and Reconciliation International (GERI).

This inspiring group of young people shared vividly their life experiences of gender, and listened with great care to each other's stories of pain, fear, and challenge of growing up as young women and men. The sharings across genders were

particularly deep, and many of the participants were brought to tears by stories of deep pain and wounding experienced by their fellow young people.

This deep sharing and absorbing of each other's stories was then reflected in the closing ceremonies, which were beautiful and joyful celebrations of sharing and appreciation for all that the other gender group brought forward.
